Sentence	Complete sentence beginning with a capital letter, ending with appropriate punctuation. Shows understanding of the meaning of the word. Does NOT include student, family, or friends in the sentence. Sentence must contain enough substance to show understanding. MUST BE IN THE STUDENTS OWN WORDS.	May not include correct capitalization or punctuation. Sentence may not completely show understanding.	Sentence does not use appropriate punctuation. Sentence does not show understanding of the word and may include self, family or friends. An attempt was made to write a sentence.	Sentence is blank
Picture	Picture drawn depicts vocabulary word. It is neatly drawn, or printed and glued.	Picture drawn is vague, messy, or not thought through.	Picture does not go with word. Picture is unable to be determined what it contains.	Blank Picture

- The Vocabulary sheet should be written by the students in their own handwriting.
- Sentences CAN NOT be copied from the internet. If the student is asked about the sentence and does not understand it, it will not be counted correct. That indicates the students did not write their own sentence and does not understand the word.
